

## Contest Rules

1. Participants must be at least 13 years old to be eligible to enter the *2017 Together for Trails Photo Contest*. Residents and visitors of the Fox Cities region are eligible to enter. Each eligible participant may submit up to 4 photos with a limit of 2 for each selected category. Each photo must be submitted with a separate photo contest entry form.
2. The photo contest will begin August 1, 2017 and ends no later than 5pm October 31, 2017. All winners will be notified no later than November 30, 2017. First, second, third, and the People's Choice Award will be recognized in Fox Cities Greenways Inc.'s newsletter, *Greenways Ink* and on our Facebook page.
3. First place winners in both categories will win \$75, second place winners will win \$50 and third place winners will win \$25, along with memberships to Fox Cities Greenways. The people's choice award wins a \$25 gift certificate and a membership to Fox Cities Greenways.
4. People's Choice Award: After the judging is completed and first -second- third place winners have been determined, these photos will be displayed during the Fox Cities Greenways Inc.'s Annual Membership Meeting. Our Membership will have an opportunity to vote from the winning photos in order to determine the People's Choice Award.
5. All photos must include trails or greenways in the Fox Cities region. A greenway is a long, narrow piece of land or trail designated for public recreation or non-motorized travel. Our Fox Cities region consists of many unique communities and multiple trails. 6. Consider how your photos illustrate the mission of Fox Cities Greenways Inc., "Fostering the development and preservation of greenways in the Fox Cities region." 7. This photo contest is conducted by Fox Cities Greenways Inc. whose decisions are final on all matters. All photos submitted to the contest come with the right for Fox Cities Greenways Inc. to use submitted photos in print publications, social media and on the FCGI website <http://foxcitiesgreenways.org>.

8. Eligible participants may only submit photos that are their property and are required to adhere to copyright rules. All entries must include the location of where the photo was taken. If a photo depicts individual (s) at a non-public event, entrant must obtain permission of the individual (s) photographed prior to entering the photo in the contest.
9. Fox Cities Greenways Inc. reserves the right to exclude photos it deems inappropriate to be entered in the contest. All submitted photos will be reviewed by our Photo Contest Award Judges.
